ACEC Illinois Board Visits Lawmakers in DC

Motor Fuel Tax

The combined February revenue (both Motor Fuel Tax Fund and Transportation Renewal Fund) was \$214.7 million. On a dollar basis, this represents a \$109.8 million dollar increase over the pre-Rebuild Illinois average (FY 16 – FY 19). This represents 9.8% increase in consumption when compared to the same pre-Rebuild Illinois period.

Motor Vehicle Registrations

The February revenue for motor vehicle registrations was \$116.8 million. This is (\$23.3 million) or 16.6% decrease over projections.

Sales Tax On Motor Fuel

Beginning in July, the law requires 40% of the State's share of the sales tax on motor fuel

shall be transferred to the Road Fund. The December sales tax transfer is \$48.5 million. In February, the monthly transfer has decreased to \$43.1 million.

Fund balances as of March 5, 2023: Road Fund: \$1,751,174,565 State Construction Account: \$1,554,813,527 Transportation Renewal Fund: \$36,912,151

Legislative Update

Over 6,500 pieces of legislation have been introduced so far this General Assembly Session.

Key components of the ACEC Illinois Legislative Agenda are advancing through the process, including:

Incentivize Engineering Talent for IDOT (<u>HB 2424</u>) (<u>SB 2190</u>): With shortages in qualified engineers facing the industry, this legislation would enable IDOT to provide student loan repayment assistance to qualifying employees that meet certain requirements, helping to incentivize educated professionals to work on the state's highest priority infrastructure projects. This legislation is sponsored by Michael Marron and Senator Ram Villivalam. *Status: Assigned to the House Appropriations Public Safety Committee for a hearing.*

Retain Illinois Students of Engineering (RISE) Tax Credit (HB 2425) (SB 2282): Helping attract and retain engineers as the industry faces a shortage of educated talent, this legislation provides for a tax credit of 10% of the salary paid to recent graduates of Illinois' engineering schools and 5% of the salary paid to recent graduates of engineering schools outside of Illinois. This legislation is sponsored by Rep. Marty Moylan and Senator Ram Villivalam. *Status: Assigned to the House Revenue & Finance Committee*

State Innovation Tax Credit (HB2423) (SB 2084): This legislation creates a State of Illinois innovation tax credit that would be administered by the Department of Revenue, rather than the IRS, aiding in the state's goal of attracting more research and development programs to Illinois. This legislation is sponsored by Rep. Marty Moylan and Senator Don DeWitte. *Status: Assigned to the House Revenue & Finance Committee*

Knowledge Transfer Innovation Act (<u>HB 2559</u>): To ensure Illinois' most innovative engineering firms are able to share their cutting-edge technology and design approaches with state agencies, this legislation allows for greater communication and knowledge transfer between the private and public sector. This legislation is sponsored by Rep. Marty Moylan. *Status: Assigned to the House Ethics & Election Committee*

In addition to these measures, ACEC Illinois is also advancing legislation, sponsored by Sen. Villivalam, that would help expedite the **land acquisition** process for IDOT and Tollway by requiring those firms be selected via QBS. <u>SB 2424</u> is in the Senate Transportation Committee this week.


